

COURT OF MAGISTRATES (MALTA) AS A COURT OF CRIMINAL JUDICATURE

The Police (Inspector Johann Fenech) vs Lily Wong, daughter of Wangeecai, born in China on the 16th December, 1973

The Court,

Having seen the charges proffered against the accused that on the 14th August, 2007 at about 5.00 p.m. in Birżebbuġia –

1. willfully committed any spoil, damage, or injury to or upon any movable or immovable property belonging to Carmel Halliday, which damage exceeds €116.47 but does not exceed €1,164.69;

2. willfully caused slight bodily harm to Carmel Halliday as certified by Dr. M. Tufigno M.D. of Paola Health Centre; Informal Copy of Judgement

3. willfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be treated summarily.

Having seen the records of the sitting of the 22nd May, 2009 from where it results that the damage caused amounts to €143.79.

Having seen the records of the sitting of the 22nd May, 2009 from where it results that the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Having heard the prosecution and the attorney for the accused regarding the punishment to be meted out to the accused.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charges as proffered. Having seen sections 325(1)(b), 221(1) and 338(dd) of the Criminal Code. The Court does not sentence the accused to a term of imprisonment but having seen section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta sets her free on condition that she commits no further offence for a period of one year from today. Moreover, having seen section 24 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta orders the accused to pay €143.79 damages to Carmel Halliday within one month from today.
