## THE POLICE INSPECTOR MARIO HABER

## VS

BRIGHT SOLOMON of Nigerian nationality, son of Solomon and Victoria, born in Edo State on the $23^{\text {rd }}$ June, 1981, bearing police no 09B-151;

## The Court;

Seen charges proffered against the above-mentioned BRIGHT SOLOMON who was charged of having:

1. On the $2^{\text {nd }}$ July, 2009 and in the previous days, in Malta, while having in his possession a passport, residence permit card and ID card issued by a competent authority, that is Ghanaian passports in the names of Bernard Kyei bearing number H0792670, Italian residence
permit card issued in same name bearing number AR4933022, had transferred these documents to another person or received these documents which were transferred to him by another person, and this in violation of Article 3 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta;
2. Also of having on the same date and circumstances made use or attempted to make use of a passport, residence permit card and ID card, issued to another person and this in violation of Article 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta;
3. Also of having on the $17^{\text {th }}$ June, 2009 escaped from a place of public custody, from Safi Detention Centre, and this in violation of Articles 151, 152 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Considered:
Seen Attorney General's consent for summary procedures to which accused finds no objection;

Seen accused's early guilty plea;
Seen Articles 3, 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta;
Articles 17, 151, and 152 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Finds accused guilty as charged and condemns him to six(6) months imprisonment suspended for one(1) year in terms of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
