THE POLICE INSPECTOR JOSEPH HERSEY

VS

AMIN AMADU aged 22 years, son of Amadu and Hafsetu, born in Nigeria on the 1st July, 1987, having Police no 08B-026, and currently detained at the Police Headquarters;

The Court:

Seen charges brought against the above-mentioned **AMIN AMADU** who was charged of having:

1. On the 13th July, 2009 as a person who embarked or disembarked from Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false

information, and this in violation of Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

2. And also of having on the same day and circumstances in Malta, knowingly made use of a forged document being an Italian foreigners' permit of stay no E5329874 and a 'Titolo di Viaggio per Stranieri' no 45872 (Chapter 9, Section 189 of the Laws of Malta).

Seen that on the initial examination of the accused he entered an admission peal, given time to consider the same;

Seen Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, Section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, and also Section 17 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Finds him guilty as charged and condemns him to six(6) months imprisonment.

Orders that the records of the case to be transmitted to the Attorney General.
