**The Court;**

After seeing the charges brought against:

Julian Eric Sanderson, 48 years, son of Eric and Monica nee' White, born in England on the 6<sup>th</sup> of December 1960, residing at 2 Hastings Road, Birkdale, Southport, Merseyside, PR8 2LS, England or 21 Spinola Court, Upper Gardens Street, St. Julians, holder of British passport 099107280;

For Having in these Islands on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2009 at about eleven forty five in the evening (11.45pm) wilfully

committed any spoil, damage or injury to or upon movable or immovable property 'barrier' which damage exceeds €116.47 (Lm50) but not the amount of €1164.7 (Lm500) to the detriment of the owner of Hotel Portomaso.

Considers:

After having seen the Articles 325 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea;

This Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, but discharges him from any punishment on condition that he does not commit another offence within the period of six (6) months from today, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 Chapter 446 of the Law of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
