**JASON JOHN CRASKE**

**TODAY THE 29<sup>TH</sup> OF SEPTEMBER, 2009.**

**The Court;**

Having seen the imputations proffered against the accused Jason John Craske, son of John and Vivienne nee' Jones, born in Rochford (England) on the 9<sup>th</sup> of April 1971, and residing at 'St. Joseph', Triq il-Qieghed, Gharghur and holder of identity card number 31508(A);

And charge him with having:

1. On the 21<sup>st</sup> of September 2009 between eleven in the evening (11.00p.m.) and midnight (12.00a.m.) whilst at the 'Monavale Pub' situated in Triq il-Halel, Bugibba, struck James Lawson Kelly on his nose and caused him an injury of grievous nature (*per durata*) as certified by Dr. Adrian Agius MD FRSC of St. James (Capua) Hospital of Sliema;

2. Moreover, on the same date, time and place, disturbed the public good order and peace by fighting and shouting and for having failed to take proper care of himself due to drunkenness;

Having seen the documents exhibited;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to all the imputations proffered;

Having confirmed his plea after being given adequate time to re-consider;

Finds him guilty;

Having seen articles 215(2) and articles 338(dd) and 338 (bb) of Chapter 9 condemns him to imprisonment for a period of six (6) months;

After considering all the circumstance of the case, the accused contrition; the fact that he made good the damages caused and the fact that his apologies were accepted by the victim concerned, orders that on the

basis of article 28A of Chapter 9 the prison term referred to above be suspended for a period of two (2) years and declares that it has explained the consequences of said suspension to the accused who acknowledged that he understood said consequences.
