Kiros Nage Isaak

The Court;

Having seen the charge brought against, Kiros Nage Isaak of 22 years, son of Kiros and Kabowsh, born in Addis Ababa, Ethopia, residing in Hal Far Open Centre Malta and holding police number 06DD-24, was arrainged before it and charged with having:

In April 2009, and the months after, in these islands, committed an offence by embarking from Malta without possession of a passport and without furnishing to the

Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require and this in breach with Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him of the consequences of his guilty plea after having afforded him sufficient time within which to withdraw his guilty plea.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him the Court has no alternative but to find the accused guilty of the said charge.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the fact that the accused has a clean criminal record. The Court also took into consideration the fact that he pleaded guilty at an early stage of the proceedings and the fact that he fully co-operated during the course of the police investigations.

The Court after having seen sections 28 and 32 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta declares the accused as guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to one(1) month imprisonment.

In terms of section 401(3) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, the Court orders that a copy of this judgement together with the acts of these proceedings are sent to the Attorney General within the time limit stipulated by Law.
