Police Inspector Carlo Ellul vs Stoyan Marinov Minev

The Court;

Having seen that the accused Stoyan Marinov Minev of 38 years, son of Marin Ivanov and Nvanka nee' Grigova, born in Bulgaria on the 29th of June, 1968, residing at Flat No. 10 'Havana Apartments', St. George's, St. Julians and holder of identity card no 0033805A and Passport No. 323391663 issued Pazardzhik on 29th December 2001 was arraigned before it and charged with having:

On the 25th April, 2007 at about 20:45 hours at St. Julians, without the intent to kill or to put the life of any person in manifest jeopardy, caused grievous bodily harm on the person of his wife Anna Stoyanova Mineva as certified by Dr. Nadia Sciberras, M.D. of St. Luke's Hospital.

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

This in breach of Art. 214, 216 (1) (b), 222 (1) (a) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

After having heard the evidence ;

Having seen all the acts of the proceedings including the Attorney General's consent dated 9th July 2007 (exhibited at folio 15 of the proceedings) for this case to be treated summarily.

Having heard that the accused declares that he has no objection that this case is heard summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to all the charges brought against him during today's hearing, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him of the consequences of his guilty plea after having afforded him sufficient time within which to withdraw his guilty plea.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him the Court has no alternative but to find the accused guilty of the said charge.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the particular circumstances of the case and the fact that the accused has a clean criminal record.

After having seen sections 214, 216 (1) (b) and 222 (1) (a) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge brought against him and in terms of Section 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, condemns him to two(2) years imprisonment suspended for a period of four(4) years from today.
