POLICE INSPECTOR JESMOND MICALLEF VS JAMIE PAUL DAY

The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Jamie Paul Day of 30 years, son of Terrence and Julie nee' Ashworth, born in Grimsby United Kingdom on the 23rd September 1978, without a fixed address and holder of English passport number 456875058.

And is charged with having between the first and second of July 2009, during the night, on these Islands, whilst at Hibernia Hotel, Depiro Street, Sliema, committed theft of several items, which theft is aggravated by value which exceeds two thousand, three hundred and twenty nine Euros and thirty seven cents (Euros 2329.37c), by place Informal Copy of Judgement

and also by time, to the detriment of Etienne Alexandres Dumoulin and/or other persons.

Having heard the evidence tendered on oath;

Having heard the plea of guilt registered by the accused;

Having heard the confirmation of the guilty plea registered by the accused after the Court accorded the accused a reasonable time for reconsideration;

Having seen the record of the proceedings;

Having heard the oral submissions of the parties;

Deliberates:

On the strength of the guilty plea registered by the accused, the Court finds the accused, Jamie Paul Day, guilty as charged and after having seen Article 261, 267, 269, 270, 279, 280 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, Article 7 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta, and issues a two (2) year Probation Order in his regard, under the supervision of the Director of Probation Services or any other Probation Officer appointed by the said Director.

The Court, in awarding punishment, took into consideration the guilty plea registered by the accused in the initial stages of the proceedings, the age of the accused and the fact that the accused is a first offender.
