The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holder of Police number O9B-050 with having:

1. on the 8<sup>th</sup> September 2009 and/or the previous days in Malta, made use of a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the principal Immigration officer with false information. Chap 217 Sec 32(1c);

- 2. on the same date and circumstances in Malta, knowingly made use of a forged document/counter fit being the above mentioned documents. Chap 9 Sec 189;
- 3. on the month of August 2009, while detained at Hal Far Detention centre, escaped from this place and custody. Chap 9 Sec 151;
- 4. on the same date and circumstances while in Malta, received/transferred documents (as above) to him by any other person. Chap 61 Sec 3(b).

Having seen the note from the Attorney General requesting that the case heard summarily, not opposed by the accused;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which plea the accused insisted even after the Court granted him time to re-consider.

Having seen all the records and documents.

## Considers:

The charges refer to breaches relating to Chapter 217, Chapter 9 and Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta.

Accused has registered a guilty plea which is volontary and unconditioned.

On the strength of accused's admission to the charges proferred against him declares him guilty and after having seen Article 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217, Article 3(b) of Chapter 61 and Article 189, 151 and 17 of Chapter 9 condemns him to six months imprisonment.
