The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against **Jeronimus Geradus Jacobus Van Ee** of Dutch Nationality, 24 years of age, son of Gerard and Elly *nee'* De Haan, born in Rotterdam on the 25<sup>th</sup> May 1984, residing in no 107, the University Residence, Robert Mifsuf Bonnici Street, Lija and holder of passport no NUR0P7HD8 issued in the Netherlands on the 28<sup>th</sup> April 2008;

With having on the 17<sup>th</sup> January 2008 at 14:15hrs at Birkirkara Police Station laid before the Executive Police an information regarding an offence knowing that such offence has not been committed, or falsely devised the traces of an offence in such a manner that criminal proceedings may be instituted for the ascertaiment of such offence;

Having heard the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of the case;

Finds the accused guilty as charged.

Having seen article 110(2) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and having considered the clean conduct sheet of the accused, condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of six (6) months which term shall not elapse unless the accused commits any offence punishable with imprisonment within a period of one (1) year from today in terms of article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the obligations of the accused arising out of this judgement;

Having noted that the prosecution was not in possession of the consent of the attorney general for this case to be tried summarily, orders that these acts be transmitted to the office of the attorney general within the time prescribed by law.
