The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holder of Polish passport number AJ9999182 issued on the 13<sup>th</sup> April 2004 and expires on the 13<sup>th</sup> April 2014 with having on the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2009, in these islands;

1. imported or brought into Malta the whole or any portion of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 7 of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

2. had in his possession the whole or any portion of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 8(d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta.

Thus whilst exhibiting the Passport, Police Conduct Certificate and A.G.'s Order, of the accused, it is requested that this case be investigated according to Law.

Heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which plea of guilt accused insisted even after given time to reconsider.

Consequently and in virtue of the voluntary and unconditional admission by the accused, declares him guilty according to the charge sheet and condemns him to six months imprisonment which by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9 are hereby being suspended for one year from today on condition that the accused does not commit a further crime punishable with imprisonment. The Court having seen Article 7, 8(d), 22 of Chapter 101.
