The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Samson Tarku of 22 years, son of Tariku and Bzunex, born on 1st January 1987 Ethiopia, residing at Tent Centre Hal- Far and holder of Identity Card number 42210A;

For Having in these islands on the night between 23rd and 24th July 2009 in St. Julian's, committed theft of two digital cameras and two mobile phones which theft exceeds €233, but less than €2330 to the detriment of

Laura Payne, Sabela Agrasar Martinez, Sarah Bressan and Netta Peppina Auvenen, which theft is aggravated by time, person and value.

Considers:

After having seen the Articles

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him three (3) months imprisonment suspended for one (1) year in accordance with the provisions of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
