The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Imasuen Osamede 26 years, son of Imasuen and Unis, born in Nigeria on the 25th August 1984, residing at Hal-Far Tent centre and having Police Number 08BBBB-05;

For Having:

- 1) on the 13th February 2010, as a person who embarked or disembarked from Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/ or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1)c of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;
- 2) also with having under the same circumstances in these islands, knowingly made use of forged documents, being a Spanish 'Permesso Di Residencia' no: E 09876534, in violation of Chapter 9 Section 189 of the Laws of Malta:

Considers:

After having seen the Articles 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta and Article 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited:

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him to a term of six (6) months imprisonment.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
