### The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Hussein Korogu, 19 years, son of Adam and Fatmati, born Ivory Coast on the 1980 and residing at Hal Far tent centre, known as Police no. 07Q-006; Informal Copy of Judgement

With having, in the months prior to the 24<sup>th</sup> February 2010, in Malta, embarked without being in possession of a passport and without furnishing the Principal Immigration Officer with the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer might have deemed proper to require;

#### Considers:

After having seen Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

#### Now, therefore, the Court:

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him to a period of three (3) months imprisonment.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
