Mohammed Yossef Ferhan

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Mohammed Yossef Ferhan, 21 years of age, born in Mogadishu, Somalia, on the 4th February 1989, son of Mohammed Yossef and Miriam, residing in Hal Far Open Centre, known with Police Boat No. 19J-082.

Was charged with having on the 28th February 2010, and later dates in Malta:

Made use or attempted to make use of a passport issued to any other person and this in violation of Article 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta; and Informal Copy of Judgement

Also with having in the same circumstances, as a person who embarked or disembarked from Malta, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard Inspector and documentary evidence tendered by prosecution;

After having heard guilty plea by accused which was confirmed by the same at a later stage during the proceedings, and seen that his criminal record is clean.

Therefore by virtue of Article 4 of Chapter 61 and Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 and since Article 4 of Chapter 61 is absorbed in Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217, finds accused guilty of charges against him and condemns him to two (2) months imprisonment.
