**Soumaila Camaras, 20 yrs, son of Drisa and Naza
born in Mali on the 01/09/90, having Police No 07HHH-
018, and currently residing at St. Paul's Bay.**

The Court;

Having seen the charges brought against the accused Soumaila Camaras who was charged with having on the 11th April, 2010, as a person who embarked from Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and

this in violation of Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Moreover, he was also charged with having under the same circumstances in these islands, knowingly made use of a forged document, being an Italian 'Totolos did DiMaggio Per Strainer' no: 930160, a 'Carat did identity' no AR6677880, and a 'Permission did Soggiorno' no: SRM705634 in violation of Chapter 9 Section 189 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen documents exhibited;

Having heard the accused admit to the charges brought against him, witch guilty was reaffirmed by her after being given sufficient time according to law to reconsider same;

Considers,

That in view of the guilty plea filed by the accused, the Court finds him guilty as charged.

That in considering the punishment to be inflicted the Court is taking into consideration the guilty plea filed by the accused at this early stage of the proceedings and his cooperation with the police.

Consequently the Court after having seen Section 32(1c) of Chapter 217 and Section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta finds accused guilty as charged and condemns him to a period of six (6) months.
