The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against Yousef Zerabrouk, born on the 14<sup>th</sup> April 1979, son of Zerabrouk and Zenabetc, holding a police number 05W-145.

Accused with having in a date not known before 21<sup>st</sup> January 2009, as a person landing or embarking in or from Malta, failed to be in possession of a passport and

failed to provide the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information that the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require according to Chapter 217, Section 28 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the defendant admit the charge brought against him and confirm his admission of guilt even after having afforded him sufficient time to reconsider his position.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the oral submissions made by the parties.

Having considered

That the accused replied guilty to the charges brought against him; the charges are consequently sufficiently proved.

That the accused co-operated with the competent authorities in their investigation and admitted the charges brought against him in the initial stages of the procedures.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment.
