The Court,

Having seen that Festus Obodo, 23 years of age, son of Festus and Margaret, born in Togo in the year 1987, known by Police no: 07EEE-037, and residing at 20/2, St. Ignatius Street, Sliema.

Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

Was charged with having on the 13th day of March, 2010 and in the previous days in Malta, with the intention of gain, helped, assisted, given advice or incited other people to attempt to enter or leave Malta against the Laws of Malta, or whether in Malta or outside Malta conspired with other people and this in breach of Article 337A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

And with having under circumstances in these islands, associated himself together with other persons in Malta or outside Malta with the intention of committing a crime in Malta (Article 337A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta) for which is punishable by imprisonment, and this in violation of Article 48A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen sections 48A and 377A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the consent given by the Attorney General for this case to be tried summarily and that defendant had no objection to his case being so tried.

Having heard the defendant admit the charges brought against him and confirm his admission of guilt even after having afforded him sufficient time to reconsider his position.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the oral submissions made by the parties.

Having considered

That the accused replied guilty to the charges brought against him; the charges are consequently sufficiently proved.

That the accused co-operated with the competent authorities in their investigation and admitted the charges brought against him in the initial stages of the procedures. Kopja Informali ta' Sentenza

For these reasons the Court, after having seen sections 48A and 337A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to three (3) years imprisonment.
