Vs

Elvir Cimirotic

Today the 19th of May, 2010.

The Court;

Having seen the imputations proferred against the accused Elvir Cimirotic, son of Damir and Senada, born in Bosinia on the 13th of June 1986 and residing at *'Garden*

View Court', Flat 4, Church Street, St. Julians and holder of passport number 45815672;

And charge him with having on the 17th May 2010, at about three o'clock in the afternoon (15:00hrs), from inside the offices with the name of *Verdun Group* situated at the *Plaza Hotel, Level 4, Suite 8, Bisazza Street, Sliema*:

1. Committed theft from the mentioned offices of a Laptop, which theft was committed to the detriment of Lars Christian Beitnes and/or other persons, which theft is aggravated by value, which exceeds the amount of two hundred and thirty-two Euro and ninety-four cents (€232.94) but does not exceed two thousand and three hundred and twenty-nine Euro and thirty-seven cents (€2,329.37), and by person;

Having seen the documents exhibited;

Having heard the accused plead guilty;

Having given the opportunity to the accused to reconsider his original plea;

Having heard him re-confirm said plea of guilt;

Finds him guilty;

Having seen articles 261 (c) (d), 267, 268 (a), 279 (a), 280 (1) of Chapter 9 and condemns him to one (1) year imprisonment;

After considering all the circumstances of the case; the young age of the accused; his clean conduct sheet and his immediate collaboration with the investigating Officer,

deems that an effective prison term is not beneficial to the accused or to society;

Having seen article 28 A of Chapter 9 orders the suspension of the said prison term for a period of one (1) year from today and underlines the fact that it is also informing the accused of the consequences of relapsing.
