Ayron James Henshaw.

The Court

Having seen the charges preferred againsty Ayron James Henshaw, son of unknown father and Patricia nee Murphy, born in Manchester (England) on the 30th December 1985 and temporarily residing in romm number 350 Qawra Palce Hotel, Qawra Road, Qawra

Being charged with:

1. On the 25th May, 2010 at about 8.20 pm, whilst in Qawra Palace Hotel, situated in Qawra Raod, Qawra,

attacked Ronnie Borg in his capacity as security guard at the said hotel and consequently hit him on his left cheek and on his right side of the neck with the result that he caused him injuries of a slight nature save complications as certified by Dr F Azzoaprdi MD of Mosta Health Centre;

- 2. Moreover on the same date, time and place failed to take proper care of himself due to drunkenness and for having disturbed the public good order by fighting and shouting
- 3. Furthermore on the same date, times and place whilst in Qawra Police Station resisted by violence or active force not amounting to public violence, PS 935 Patrick Cassar and PC 1185 William Saliba, persons lawfully charged with a public duty when they were in the execution of the law.
- 4. Furthermore on the same date, times and place, uttered obscene and blasphemous words in the public.

Having seen all the documents of the file.

Having seen that the defendant has filed an early guilty plea.

Once the defendant has pleaded guilty to the charges these have been proved in accordance with the law.

Conclusion

The Court, having seen articles 28A, 221(3)(b), 338(b), 96(a), 339(1)(e) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta finds the defendant guilty of all the charges preferred against him. The Court notes that the defendant has filed an early guilty plea and that he has a clean record sheet. It is condemning the defendant to a period of three months imprisonment which should not become operative unless the defendant commits a crime within 1 year from today.

The Court explained section 28A to the defendant.

The Court orders that the record of this case should be sent to the Attorney General.
