The Police Sp Nezren Grixti vs Petrovic Milos

The Court

Having seen the charges laid against Petrovic Milos, 27 years of age, Nationality Serbian, son of Zoran and Lilian, born in Serbia on the 13th November 1982 and residing 117 St Helen Street Sliema, holder of passport number P/N 004414109

Charged with having on the 24th May 2010 and or the previous days in Malta, forged, altered or tampered with a passport/s or used or had in his possession a Schengen Visa Sticker which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, Chapter 61 Sec 5.

Informal Copy of Judgement

Charged also with having on the same date and circumstances while in Malta knowingly made use of a forged documents being the above mentioned Schengen Visa Sticker / passport Chapter 9 Sec 189.

And also charged with having on the same date and circumstances and / or the previous days in Malta, made use of a false return, false statement or false representation and / or furnished the Principal Immigraiton Officer with false information, Chapter 217 Section 32 (1c).

Having seen all the relevant documentation available in the file. Having heard the defendant file a guilty plea, which guilty plea he confirmed after being given sufficient time to reflect on it.

Once the defendant has filed a guilty plea, then the charges have been proved in accordance with the law.

The Court after having seen Article 28A of Chapter 9, Article 5 of Chapter 61, Article 189 of Chapter 9, Article 32 (1) (c) of Chapter 317, finds the defendant guilty as charged, so however the third charge is absorbed in the second charge in accordance with Section 17H of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and is condemning the defendant to a period of 6 months imprisonment which shall remain suspended for 18 months unless the defendant commits any offence during the said period of 18 months.

The Court explained Article 28A of Chapter 9 to the defendant as simply as possible.
