The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holder of Police Boat number 08VV-001, charged with:

- 1. having in January 2010 and/or the previous days in Malta, forged altered or tempered an Italian Residence permit or used or had in his possession of this document which he knew to be forged, altered or tempered with, Chapter 61 Sec 5.
- 2. having on the same date and circumstances while in Malta, knowingly made use of a forged document being

the above mentioned residence permit, Chapter 9 Sec 189.

- 3. having on the same date and circumstances and/or the previous days in Malta, made use of a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, Chapter 217 Sec 32(1c).
- 4. having on the same date and circumstances committed an offence by embarking from Malta without possession of a passport and without furnishing to the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require and this in breach with Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the Attorney General's request that the case be heard summarily;

Having heard accused register a guilty plea on which he insisted even after the Court gave him time to reconsider;

That on the voluntary and unconditional admission by the accused to the charges brought against him, having seen Article 5 of Chapter 61, 189 of Chapter 9 and 28, 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 condemns him to a term of one year imprisonment which by application of Article 289 of Chapter 9 suspends for two years from today provided accused does not commit a further indictable offence within the suspended period.

The Court explained to the accused his responsibilities according to this judgment.
