The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holder of police number 08BBBB-082, charged with having in the months prior the 4<sup>th</sup> July 2010, in Malta:

1. received a passport, that is, a Nigerian passport no A4185837, transferred to him by any other person (Art 3(b) of Chapter 61);
2. made use, or attempted to make use of a passport, that is, a Nigerian passport no A4185837, issued to any other person (Art 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta);

Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen the Attorney General's request that the case be heard summarily to which the accused did not object;

Having heard the accused enter a guilty plea to the charges brought against him on which plea the accused insisted even after having been given time by the Court to reconsider;

In view of the voluntary and unconditional admission of the accused, declares him guilty of the charges brought against him.

Having seen article 3(b) and 4 of Chapter 61 and Article 17 of Chapter 9 condemns him to imprisonment for a period of two years which are being suspended for 4 years from today provided the accused does not commit an indictable offence within the operative period in virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9.

The Court explained the import of the judgment to the accused in terms of Article 28A(4) of Chapter 9.
