The Court.

Having seen the charges proffered against the accused, namely:

- 1. with having on the night between the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 sometime between 2000 hours and 2400 hours in Qawra, St. Paul's Bay caused grievous injuries on the person of Dylan Gerada, which injuries were certified by Dr. Edward Zammit MD at the Mater Dei Hospital;
- 2. at the same place, date, time and circumstances willfully disturbed the public good order or the public peace and order;

3. at the same place, date, time and circumstances uttered obscene or indecent words in public.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be heard summarily.

Having seen the records of the sitting of the 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 whereby the injured party declared that he has no further interest in the case.

Having seen the records of the sitting of the 28<sup>th</sup> July, 2010 whereby the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Having heard the prosecution and counsel for the defence with reference to the punishment to be meted out to the accused.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charges as proffered. Having seen sections 216 and 338(bb)(dd) of the Criminal Code. The Court does not condemn the accused to a period of imprisonment but sets him free under section 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta on condition that he commits no further offence for a period of six months from today.
