The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused of 32 years, son of Stephen and Semet born in Liberia on the 10/02/1978 and residing in an unknown address, charged with:

1. on the 3rd July 2010, previous dates and later dates in Malta, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

2. having committed any other kind of forgery, or knowingly made use of any other forged document, and this in violation of Article 183, 184 and 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the accused plead guilty on which plea he insisted even after being given time to reconsider.

Having seen all documents and records.

On accused's guilty plea which is voluntary and unconditional, declares him guilty of the charges brought against him.

Having seen Article 32(c) of Chapter 217 and Article 183, 184, 189, 17 of Chapter 9 condemns accused to a term of imprisonment of two years which by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 it is suspending for four years from today.

The Court explained the import of the judgment to the accused in accordance to Article 28A(4) of Chapter 9.
