The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Henry Agbedia, 24 years, son of Agbedia and Stella, born Ugara, Nigeria on the 12th September 1986, residing at Hal Far tent village and known as Police No. 07HHH-07; Informal Copy of Judgement

With having in the months prior to the 23rd August 2010, in Malta, embarked without being in possession of a passport and without furnishing the Principal Immigration Officer with the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer might have deemed proper to require;

Considers:

After having seen Articles 28 Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

Considers;

Now, therefore, the Court:

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged and condemns him three (3) months imprisonment.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
