The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Mulualem Ayle Yonas, Ehtiopian National, born in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia on the 29th January 1985, son of Mulualem and Muluabay, residing at Safi Open Centre and known with Police No. 06QQ-022;

For Having;

1) On the 23rd September 2010 and in the previous days in Malta while having in his possession Passports

issued by a competent authority, that is Maltese Alien's Passport bearing number 9005610, issued in the name of Mohamed Juhar Awel, had transferred this document to another person or received this document which was transferred to him by another person Chapter 61, Section 3 of the Laws of Malta;

- 2) Also with having on the same date, time and circumstances made use or attempted to make use of Passport, issued to another person, that is the mentioned document Chapter 61, Section 4 of the Laws of Malta;
- 3) And charge him also with having on the same date, time and circumstances made false return, false statement or false representation to the Principal Immigration Officer Chapter 217, Section 32 (1c) of the Laws of Malta:

Considers:

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited:

After having seen Articles Section 3 and Section 4 of Chapter 61 and Section 32 (1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

Considers further:

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, and condemns him to a term of six (6) months imprisonment suspended for one (1) year in accordance with the provisions of Article 28A of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
