The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holders of police number 08KK-089, charged with having in the months prior the 1st September 2010 in Malta:

- 1. escaped from a place of custody (Lyster Detention Centre, Hal Far) in terms of Articles 151 and 160 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.
- 2. embarked without being in possession of a passport and without furnishing the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information an such other information as

the Principal Immigration Officer might have deemed proper to require.

Having seen the note from the Attorney General that the case be heard summarily;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges proffered against him on which plea the accused insisted even after having been given time to reconsider:

Decides, after having seen Article 151 of Chapter 9 and Article 28 of Chapter 127, to condemn the accused to a period of one year imprisonment which it orders that it be suspended for two years from today by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9.

The Court has explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgment in terms of Article 28(4) of Chapter 9.
