#### The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Eric Aigbe 26 years, son of Nusahajr and Juliet born in Edo States on the 20<sup>th</sup> February 1984, residing at St. Paul's Bay and having Police no. 08BBBB-85;

## For Having:

1) On the 7<sup>th</sup> October 2010, as a person who embarked or disembarked from Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration

Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1) (c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

2) Moreover he is also charged with having under the same circumstances in these islands, knowingly made use of a forged document, being a Spanish residence permit no. E1 2195096, in violation of Article 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

#### Considers:

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law:

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having seen Articles 32 (1) (c) of Chapter 217 and Article 189 of Chapter 9 of the Law of Malta;

#### **Considers further:**

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, and condemns him to a term of three (3) months imprisonment.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
