VS

John Dillon, 16 years, son of Ronald Michael and Charlotte Jane nee' Young, born in Rabat (Gozo), date of birth 20/06/1992, residing at Sutana Flats, Flat 2, Triq it-Torri, Xlendi, holder of Maltese Identity Card number 22392(G);

The Court:

Having seen the charge brought against John Dillon charged with having in Xlendi I/o Munxar (Gozo) and

various other areas on these Islands, on the 21st Febuary 2009, and previous year before this date, and time;

- a) had in his possession the resin obtained from the plant Cannabis, or any other preparation of which such resin formed the base, in terms of Section (8) and (d) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;
- b) sold or otherwise dealth in the whole or any portion of the plant Cannabis in terms of Section 8 (e) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Having seen the charges;

Having seen the documents exhibited;

Having seen the consent of the Attorney General dated 5th June 2009:

Having heard the accused admit to the charges brought against him which guilty plea was reaffirmed by the accused after having been given sufficient time according to Law to reconsider the same;

Considers:

That in view of the guilty plea filed by the accused the Court finds the accused guilty as charged;

That in considering the punishment to be inflicted the Court is taking into consideration the early guilty plea filed by the accused, the clear criminal record of accused and also the fact that in this case the Court is going to apply Section 22 (9) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta;

Consequently the Court after having seen Sec 8 (a) (d) (e), 22 (2) (b), 22 (9) of Chapter 101 of the Laws of Malta, finds the accused guilty as charged and condems him to a fine of four hundred and seventy Euro (€470);

The Court orders the destruction of document F and appoints Mario Mifsud to carry out this duty.
