Thiemele Nidjou Mohamoud Hasan Mousa Jama Abdi Ahmed

The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holders of police numbers 07CCC-017, 09H-024 and 09C-033 respectively, and charged with:

Thiemele Nidjou alone:

In 2008 and the months previous and after dates in Malta, made use or attempted to make use of a passport issued

to any other person and this in violation of Article 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta.

Mohamoud Hasan Mousa and Jama Abdi Ahmed alone for having:

Under the same circumstances, in Malta, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the Attorney General's request that the case be heard summarily to which the accused did not oppose.

Having seen all records and documents.

Considers:

That accused registered a guilty plea on which plea they insisted even after the Court gave them time to reconsider.

On the voluntary and unconditional admission to the charges the Court having seen Article 4 of Chapter 6 and Article 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 declares them guilty. It acquits accused Thiemele Nidjou by application of Article 22 of Chapter 446 for three months from today; condemns each of the other two accused to a period of imprisonment of three months.
