The Court,

After having seen the charges brought against the accused Norman Jones, 66 years old, son of Thomas Joseph and Doris nee` Fish, born in Ramsbottom, United Kingdom, on the 29th July 1935, and at present residing at Room 521, Qawra Palace Hotel, St Paul`s Bay, and holder of Passport 033653795:

1. For having on the 19th January 2002 at about 8.50 a.m, from St Paul's Bay, committed the theft of a vehicle,

make HICOM, white coloured, and bearing registration number DBF-514.

- The gain contemplated by Norman Jones was the mere use of the vehicle stolen and the theft was committed to the detriment of Mark Aquilina, Director of Golden Harvest Limited.
- That Norman Jones does not have the means to sustain himself and is liable to become a burden on public funds.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings;

Having seen that the accused during today's sitting pleaded guilty;

Finds the accused guilty

Having seen Section 288 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Reprimands and admonishes him.

Having seen the prosecution's request in terms of Sections 14 and 15 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, grants the said request, **declares the guilty party a**

prohibited immigrant and orders the issue of a removal order against him.
