The Police (Inspector Geoffrey Azzopardi) vs

Charles Osagiede, son of Osagiede Pulle, born in Nigeria on the 6<sup>th</sup> November, 1986, Police no. 08KK-022

The Court,

Having seen the charge proffered against the accused with having in the months prior to the 17<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2010 in Malta:

Embarked without a passport and without furnishing the Principal Immigratiion Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may have deemed proper to require in terms of section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen the note of the Attorney General whereby he gave his consent that this case be tried summarily.

Informal Copy of Judgement

Having seen the records of the case of the 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2010 whereby the accused admitted to the charge as proferred.

Having heard the prosecution and defence counsel of the accused with regard to the punishment to be awarded.

Consequently, this Court finds the accused guilty of the charge as proffered. Having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the laws of Malta condemns him to a period of imprisonment of six months. Having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code orders that such punishment be suspended, unless the accused commits another offence punishable with imprisonment, for a period of two years from today.
