The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holders of police number 08TTT-62 and 08TTT-41 respectively, charged with:

1. having on the 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010, previous and later dates in Malta committed any other kind of forgery, or knowingly made use of any other forged document, and this in violation of Article 183, 184 and 189 of Chapter 9.
2. having on the 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010, previous and later dates, in Malta, made use or caused to be made a false

return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32(1c) of Chapter 217.

Having seen the Attorney General's note that the case be heard summarily to which the accused gave their consent.

Having heard the accused enter a guilty plea to the charges brought against them.

Having seen all the documents and records.

Considers:

That on accused voluntary and unconditional plea of guilt to the charges.

Having seen Articles 183, 184, 17 of Chapter 9, Article 32(1)(c) condemns them to imprisonment for a period of thirteen months which by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9 it is suspending for 4 years from today in so far as he does not commit a further offence during the operative period.

The Court duly explained to the accused his responsibilities in terms of Article 28(4) of Chapter 9.
