The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused holder of police number 09E-003, charged with having on the 2nd November 2010 and in the prior weeks, in Malta:

1. forged, altered or tampered with any passport or used or had in her possession any passport which she knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, in terms of Article 5, Chapter 61.

2. without lawful authority used or had in her possession any forged document required for the

purposes of the Immigration Act, in terms of Article 32(1)(f), Chapter 217.

3. knowingly made use of the forged documents, that is Italian residence permit, Italian Identity Card and Italian Aliens' passport in terms of Article 189, Chapter 9.

Having seen the consent by the Attorney General that the case be heard summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which plea the accused insisted even after having been given time by the Court to reconsider.

That in view of accused's admission to the charges which is voluntary and unconditional. Having seen Article 189, and 17 of Chapter 9, Article 5 of Chapter 61 and Article 32(I)(f) of Chapter 217 condemns him to one year's imprisonment which by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9 is being suspended for four years.

The Court has explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgment.
