The Court,

Having seen that the accused Ousmane Sare of 30 years son of Yousuf Sare and Fatima, born in Ivory Coast on the 25th November 1980 and residing at Marsa tent village, known as Police no. 07Q-042 was arrainged before it with having:

In the months prior to the 6th January, 2011 in Malta, embarked without being in possession of a passport and without furnishing the Principal Immigration Officer with the prescribed information and such other information as Informal Copy of Judgement

the Principal Immigration Officer might have deemed proper to require (Chap 217 sec 28).

Having seen all the acts of the proceedings including the Attorney General's consent dated 7th January 2011 (exhibited a. folio 5 of the proceedings) for this case to be treated summarily.

Having heard the accused declare that he has no objection that this case is heard summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him of the consequences of his guilty plea after having afforded him sufficient time within which to withdraw his guilty plea.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him the Court has no alternative but to find the accused guilty of the said charge.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the fact that the accused co-operated with the police as well as the fact that he filed a guilty plea at such an early stage of the proceedings.

For the above mentioned reasons and after having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta the Court finds the accused guilty of the change brought against him and condemns him six(6) months imprisonment.
