The Court,

Having seen that Keita Mate, 25 years of age, son of Mamadu Kieta and Udien, born in Bamako, Mali in 1986, and currently residing at Marsa Open Centre bearer of police number 08YY-027.

Was charged with having on the 24<sup>th</sup> January 2011, as a person who embarked or disembarked from Malta, made or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of section 32 (1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta,

And with having under the same circumstances in these islands, knowingly made use of a forged document, being a Malian passport number B0129950 and a Spanish *Permiso de Residencia* bearing number E12663007 in violation of section 189 Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and section 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the defendant admit the charges brought against him and confirm his admission of guilt even after having afforded him sufficient time to reconsider his position.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the oral submissions made by the parties.

Having considered

That the accused replied guilty to the charges brought against him; the charges are consequently sufficiently proved.

As regards the penalty to be meted out the Court considered the nature of the offences of which defendant is being found guilty on the one hand and his co-operation with the competent authorities on the other hand.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen section 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta and section 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, on his

admission finds defendant guilty of the charges brought against him and condemns him to six (6) months imprisonment.
