The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused of 32 years old, Nationality Togo, son of Halil and Aminad born in Togo on the 01/01/1979, residing at Marsa Open Centre, Marsa, Malta Police Immigration Number 06K-023.

And charge him with having on the 12th February 2011 and the months previous, while in Malta, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Informal Copy of Judgement

Under the same circumstances, you have committed any other kind of forgery, or knowingly made use of any other forged document, and this in violation of Articles 183, 184 and 189 of chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

While exhibiting the suspected counterfeit documents and personal details form of the accused, the Prosecution humbly requested the Court to investigate this case according to law.

Having heard the evidence tendered on oath;

Having seen the record of the proceedings;

Having heard the plea of guilt registered by the accused;

Having heard the confirmation of the plea of guilt, after the Court accorded a reasonable time for reconsideration;

Having heard the oral submissions;

Deliberates:

On the strength of the registration of a guilty plea by the accused, the Court finds the accused **Chatikpe Kamala Deen Halid** guilty as charged and after having seen Article 183, 184, 189 and 28A of Chapter 9 of the laws of Malta and Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta condemns the accused **Chatikpe Kamala Deen Halid to 7 months imprisonment suspended for one (1) year.**

The Court explained the consequences of a suspended Sentence to the accused in a manner to ensure that he fully understood the repercussions thereof.

This punishment was awarded after the Court took in to consideration the fact that the accused was a first offender, that he registered a guilty plea in the early stages of the proceeding and the cooperation that the accused showed to the police.
