The Police (Insp. Chris Pullicino) vs Anghel Mirabela

The Court;

Having seen the accusation brought against **Anghel Mirabela** aged 18 years, daughter of Mircea Remus Rostas and Gaba *nee*' Logojana born in Romania on the 2nd May 1993 and residing in Mtarfa holder of identity card number KX 589468

With having during the night between th 26th and the 27th of May 2011 some time around 00:30hrs, at Paceville, St. Julians, committed theft of a mobile phone, which theft is aggravated by time and value which is more that two hundred thirty two euros and ninety three cents euro but

les than two thousand three hundred and twenty nine euros and thirty seven cents euro and was committed to the detriment of Rachel Bonavia and/or other person/s;

Having heard the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of the case;

Finds the accused guilty as charged;

Having seen articles 261 (c) and (f), 267, 270, 280(1) of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

Having considered that the accused registered a plea of guilt in an early stage of these proceedings and that the accused may be considered a first offender and that a penatly of imprisonment is not indicated in these circumstances. Considered also that the stolen property is now in the possession of the prosecution;

Discharges the accused with the specific condition that she does not commit any other offence within a period of two (2) years form today in terms of article 22 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta.

The Court explained the obligations of the accused arising form this judgement and ensured that the accused, through the Court interpreter, understood the same;

Since the prosecution did not have the consent of the attorny general for this case to be tried summarily, the Corut orders that these acts be trasmitted to the attorney general in terms of law.
