The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused of Niger Nationality, S/o Teidu & Adisa, born in Niger in 1978, and holder of Police number 08HH-019, charged with having during the month of December 2010 while in these islands, and before committed an offence by embarking from Malta without possession of a passport and without furnishing to the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to

require and this in breach with Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which plea of guilt he insisted even after the Court gave him time to reconsider.

Having seen all the acts and records of the case.

## Considers:

That from the statement released to the police, the charge is well documented and proved; this and the voluntary and unconditional admission proves the charge beyond all reasonable doubt.

Having seen Article 28 and 32 of Chapter 217 condemns him to six months imprisonment which by virtue of Article 28A of Chapter 9 is being suspended for 1 year.

The Court has explained to the accused his responsibilities for this judgment.
