The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused son of Mohamed and Nadne, born in Waky Ivory Coast, holder of police number 08B-003, charged with having during the month of August 2010 while in these islands, and before committed an offence by embarking from Malta without possession of a passport and without furnishing to the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require and this in breach with Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta. Informal Copy of Judgement

Accused having registered a guilty plea on which he insisted even after the Court gave him time to reconsider.

Considers the voluntary and unconditional plea of guilt registered by the accused; declares him guilty of the crime for which he is charged; having seen Article 28 of Chapter 217 condemns him to six months imprisonment which by application of Article 28A of Chapter 9 are being suspended for one year from today.

The Court explained to the accused his responsibilities according to the judgment.
