The Police (Ins. Geoffrey Azzopardi) vs Dauda Traore

The Court;

Having seen the accusations brought forward of **Duada Traore** of 25 years, son of Inci Traore and Baru Sissoki, born in Mali on the 1st February, 1986 and residing at Hal Far Tent Village, Police Number 08EEE-022:

With having on the 11th July, 2011 and in the previous weeks in Malta;

1. received a passport transferred to him by any other person (Art 3 (b) of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta)

2. made use, or attempted to make use of a passport issued to any other person (Art 4 of Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta)

3. in relation to any information to be given under or for purposes of Immigration Act, made or caused to be made any false return. False return or false representation (Art 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta)

4. rendered himself a recidivist in terms of Art 49 and 50 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the plea of guilt;

Having seen the records of the case;

Having asked the accused had sufficient time to think about his plea of guilt and whether he was aware of the penalties tied to these charges for which questions the accused answered in the affirmative and confirmed his plea of guilt;

Finds the accused guilty as charged;

Having seen articles 3(b) and 4 Chapter 61 of the Laws of Malta, 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217 and article 49 and 50 of Chapter 9 of the same Laws;

Having seen the conduct sheet of the accused;

Condemns the accused to a term of imprisonment of six (6) months from today.

The Court orders that these acts be transmitted to the attorney general according to law since the prosecution did not have the consent for this case to be tried summarily.
