The Court,

Having seen the charges against Egerue Chizoba Collins, born in Lagos Nigeria on the 31st August 1989 and resident at the Hal Far Open Centre Malta bearer of Police Immigration Number 08TTT024.

Charged with having in 2010, previous months and later dates in Malta, landed or embarked from Malta, without being in possession of a passport, not having furnished to the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information and such other information as the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require and this in violation of Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta.

Having heard the defendant admit the charge brought against him and confirm his admission of guilt even after having afforded him sufficient time to reconsider his position.

Having seen the acts of the proceedings.

Having heard the oral submissions made by the parties.

Having considered

That the accused replied guilty to the charge brought against him; the charge is consequently sufficiently proved.

That the accused fully co-operated with the competent authorities in their investigation and admitted the charge brought against him in the initial stages of the procedures.

For these reasons the Court, after having seen section 28 of Chapter 217 of the laws of Malta, on his admission finds defendant guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns him to three (3) months imprisonment.
