the 1st January, 1988, Police number 08BB007

The Court,

Having seen the charges proffered against the accused
that on the 13th January, 2011 at about 0500 hours at Hal-
Far:

1. willfully caused grievous injuries to the body of
Kaltum Abdi Abdilahi as certified by Dr. J. Zammit of
Mater Dei Hospital;
2. willfully disturbed the public good order or the public
peace.

Having seen the note filed by the Attorney General on the 17th June, 2011 whereby the Attorney General determined that from the preliminary investigation there might result an offence or offences under the provisions of:

- a. sections 216, 217, 218(1)(b) and 218(2) of the Criminal Code;
- b. section 338(m)(dd) of the Criminal Code; and
- c. section 17 of the Criminal Code;

transmitted the records of the case to this Court to decide upon such an offence or offences.

Having seen the records of the case of the 4th July, 2011 whereby the accused gave her consent so that this case be treated summarily.

Having seen the records of the case of the 4th July, 2011 whereby the accused admitted to the charges as proffered.

Having heard the submissions put forward by the prosecution and the lawyer of the accused in relation to the punishment to be meted out.

Consequently, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charges as proffered. Having seen sections 216(1)(b), 217, 218(2) and 338(m)(dd) of the Criminal Code condemns her to a period of imprisonment of two years. Having seen section 28A of the Criminal Code orders that such punishment be suspended for a period of four years unless the accused commits a further offence punishable with imprisonment during the said period.
