Ismail Keita

The Court,

Having seen that the accused Ismail Keita, 27 years of age, born in Mali, holder of police number 07A-010.

Was charged for having on the 21st September 2011 and in the preceding weeks in Malta:

1. In relation to any information to be given under or for the purposes of the Immigration Act, made or caused to be made any false return, false statement or false representation;

- 2. Made use or attempted to make use of a passport issued to any other person;
- 3. Forged, altered or tampered with any passport or used or had in his possession any passport which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with;
- 4. Render himself a recidivist by a sentence of the Court of Magistrate dated 25th July 2009.

After seeing acts of proceedings;

After hearing examination of the accused whereby he pleaded guilty to all the charges brought against him, and the confirmation by the accused of such plea when given the appropriate time to reconsider his position, and after seeing Article 32(1)(c) of Chapter 217, Articles 4 and 5 of Chapter 61, Articles 31, 17(h), 49 and 50 of Chapter 9, whereby the first and second charges are absorbed in the third charge, and condemns him to nine (9) months imprisonment.
