The Court,

Having seen that the accused Santino Oghogho, Nigerian national born in Benin City, Nigeria on the 7th March 1988, son of Oghogho and Juliet and holder of Police No 06SS-008 was arraigned before it and charged with having:

In a date between January and December 2009, as a person landing or embarking in or from Malta, failed to be in possession of a passport and failed to provide the Principal Immigration Officer the prescribed information

and such other information that the Principal Immigration Officer may deem proper to require (Cap 217, Sec 28 of the Laws of Malta).

Having seen all the acts of the proceedings including the Attorney General's consent dated 26th October 2011 (exhibited a. folio 8 of the proceedings) for this case to be treated summarily.

Having heard the accused declare that he has no objection that this case is heard summarily.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him, notwithstanding the fact that the Court warned him of the consequences of his guilty plea after having afforded him sufficient time within which to withdraw his guilty plea.

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charge brought against him the Court has no alternative but to find the accused guilty of the said charge.

With regards to punishment the Court took into consideration the fact that the accused pleaded guilty at an early stage of the proceedings as well as the seriousness of the charges and demmes that an effective prison term is the most adequate punishment.

After having seen Section 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta, the Court finds the accused guilty of the charge brought against him and condemns the accused to two(2) months imprisonment.
