The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Cyrill Oliver Schmid of 19 years, son of Philipp and Ivonne nee' Steudler born on the 2nd February 1992 in Hagglingen AG Switzerland, residing at Blue Mountain Appartments, App.2, St. George's Road, St. Julian's and holder of Swiss identification card number C2805665; Informal Copy of Judgement

With having on the 18th October 2011 between 00.00am and 01.00am whilst being inside the Hugo's Bar situated in St. Rita Street, St. Julians, committed aggravated theft qualified by time and value of cash amount of \in 350 to the detriment of Ruben Bonnici;

And furthermore with having committed an offence during the operative period of a probation order given on the 18 October, 2011, by Magistrate Miriam Hayman, which judgement is final and cannot be changed;

Considers:

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having seen Articles 261, 267, 270 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta;

And Article 7 of Chapter 446 of the Laws of Malta;

After having seen the accused admit the charges brought against him, which admission was confirmed by him after having been given due time to reconsider in accordance with the law;

Now, therefore, for these reasons;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, but discharges him from any punishment on condition that he does not commit another offence within the period of one (1) year from today, in accordance with the provisions of Article 22 Chapter 446 of the Law of Malta.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
