The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Edwin Tugah of 27 years, son of Adam and Fatma, born in Ghana, on the 22nd March 1985, residing at Hal Far Malta and holder of Police number 06GG-019;

For having;

1) On the 18th November 2011 and the months before, at the Malta International Airport, in Malta, he has committed any other kind of forgery, or knowingly made

use of any other forged document and this in violation of Articles 183, 184 and 189 of Chapter 9 of the Laws of Malta:

2) Also for having under the same circumstances, made use or caused to be made a false return, false statement or false representation and/ or furnished the Principal Immigration Officer with false information, and this in violation of Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

Considers:

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having seen Articles 183, 184, 189 of Chapter 9 and Article 32 (1c) of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

Now, therefore, for these reasons;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, and condemns him to a term of seven (7) months imprisonment.

The Court explained in clear words the terms of the judgement to the accused.
