## The Court;

After seeing the charges brought against:

Friday Onahor of 29 years, son of Steven and Comfort, born in Edo States, Nigeria on the 15<sup>th</sup> February 1982, residing at Hal Far Malta and holder of Police number 09B-256

For having on the 9<sup>th</sup> December 2010 and the months after and previous, in Malta, he has landed or embarked from or in Malta and was not in possession of a passport and have not furnished to the Principle Immigration Officer

the prescribed information and such other information as the Principle Immgiration Officer may deem proper to require, and this in violation of Article 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

#### Considers:

After having heard the evidence and the documents exhibited;

After having seen Articles 28 of Chapter 217 of the Laws of Malta;

#### Now, therefore, for these reasons;

After having heard the accused's plea and after having given the time prescribed by Law for the accused to consider his plea, this Court finds the said accused guilty as charged, and condemns him to a term of one (1) month imprisonment.
