The Court,

Having seen the charges brought against the accused, son of Chizoba and Josephine, with Maltese ID Card 0045604A, charged him with having on the 8th November 2011 in these islands:

1. Forged, altered or tampered with a Nigerian Passport bearing his name and number A1569287 or used or had in his possession a Passport, which he knew to be forged, altered or tampered with, (Cap 61, Sec 5 of the Laws of Malta). Informal Copy of Judgement

2. And charge him also with having on the same date, time and circumstances committed any other kind of forgery, or having knowingly made use of any other forged document, in the mentioned documents (Cap 9, Sec 189 of the Laws of Malta).

3. And charge him also with having on same date, time and circumstances, forged any document or true copy of a document or an entry made in pursuance of this act (Cap 217, Sec 32 (Id) of the Laws of Malta).

Having seen the Attorney General's note that the case be heard

Summarily;

Having heard the accused plead guilty to the charges on which he insisted even after the Court gave him time and reconsider;

On the strength of accused's admission to the charges, finds him guilty.

Having seen Article 5 of Chapter 61, Article 32 (1) (d) of Chapter 217, Article 189 and 17 (b) (h) of Chapter 9 condemns him a period of two years imprisonment which are being suspended by application of Article 28 A of Chapter 9 for the period of four years from today provided the accused does not commit within the operative period of the suspended sentence a further offence that carries imprisonment.

Orders the confiscation of the exhibited passport.
